

APPLICATION FOR DISPENSATION

S.33 of the 2011 Localism Act permits a member or co-opted member of a parish council with a disclosable pecuniary interest to submit a written request to the proper officer at the parish council for the parish council to grant a dispensation to relieve him/her of the restrictions in s.31(4), namely to participate in a discussion or vote on a matter in which he/she has a disclosable pecuniary interest.
